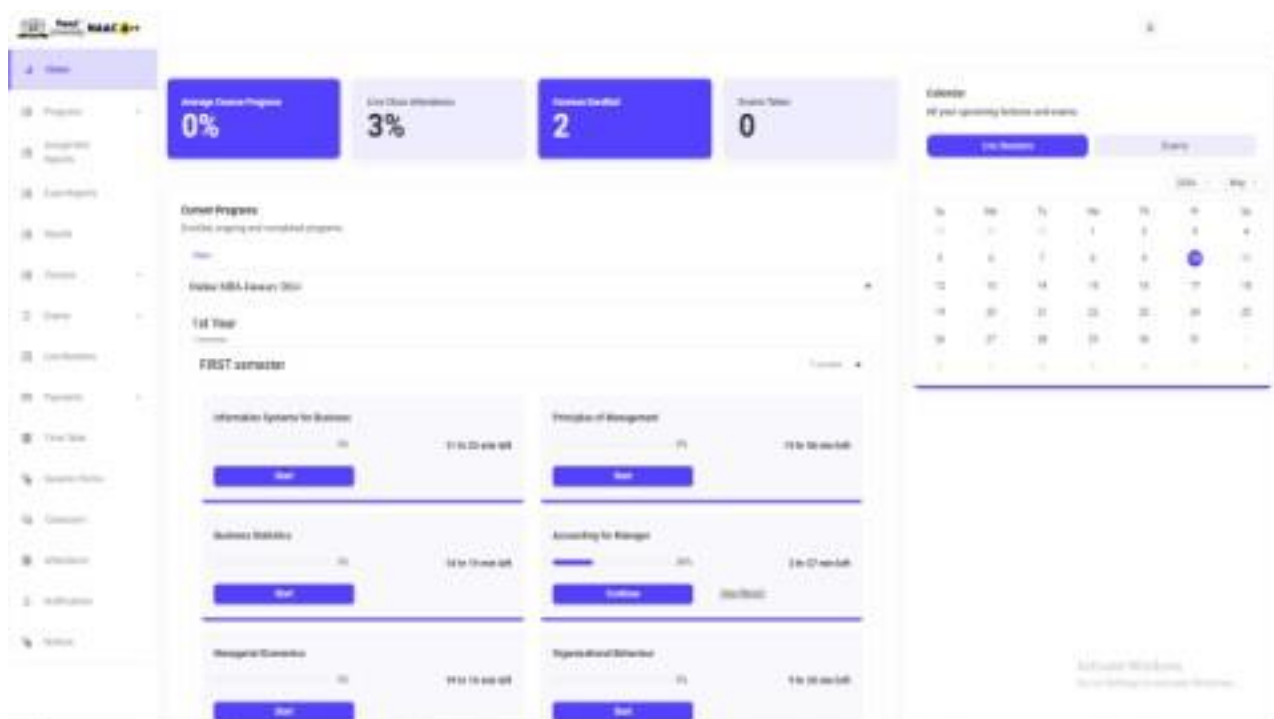
### Information about “E-Learning Materials” in 4 quadrants (OL Mode Programmes)
